

## His Story Timeline

Children love this timeline as it is fun to color, cut and paste on different pictures. The pages can be simply turned in a notebook or laid out into one long timeline. With one glance they can tell you when in history these events took place. Parents love it because they can “see” the whole picture and help their children “see” also. And each child can have their “own” timeline contained in a small place. As a family you can choose to place the key links onto the wall of your home for easy access and to refer to often.

Think of a very long chain with sections hooked together with many large links. The links are held above while sections of the chain dangles in a loop below each link. The LINKS are the major events in Christ’s Story. Under each major link within the looped chain are the stories, events, documents that occurred or people that lived around that time period.

The scriptures tell us, “there is a welding **link** ... between the fathers and the children ... it is necessary in the ushering in of the dispensation of the fullness of times... that a whole and complete and perfect **union**, and **welding together** of dispensations, and keys, and powers, and glories should take place, and be revealed from the days of Adam even to the present time.” (D&C 128:18) This timeline helps both parents and children to LINK the stories, the dispensations, the glory from Adam to our personal lives together. It LINKS our story with Christ, His Story!

This timeline is very flexible. Below are some suggested stories and events. Use your imagination and fill it in with whatever you are studying now. Enjoy!
